



What is this fundraising for?

Start fundraising for your students 8th grade trip to Washington DC. By beginning your earnings as soon as possible, the possibilities for your savings to accumulate will increase. Savings are earmarked individually for students based on anyone whose card is linked to that student's account.

Do I have to have a MyWay Account?

YES! This is a crucial step. The card numbers need to be listed in your account tab at www.buschs.com. If you do not link it to your MyWay account, the savings won't go towards your student.

What if we decide not to attend the trip after fundraising?

Due to the nature of this fundraiser, if you participate, and then decide to NOT attend the DC trip in 8th grade, your savings will go towards scholarships to be awarded in future years.

How do I participate?

You only need to obtain a Busch's card one time through us. Each card begins with a zero balance and can be recharged at any Busch's register with additional value between \$5 and \$500. You can even use a credit card to recharge your card while checking out at the register. Busch's will keep track of cards purchased through Scrip, so each month, Busch's will send a check to our organization for 5% or 3% of the value of the recharges on cards originally purchased through the SCRIP program.

Can other people support my student?

Yes! Students can also pass cards to neighbors or relatives who also shop at any Busch's store.

How is the card recharged?

Cards can be recharged at the register at any Busch's.

When do I get my check?

Sales from will be recorded from first use of card until the month before the DC trip departure. Checks will be mailed to you at your address. We will give all families the option of being paid out in January or waiting until April.

Families are still expected to make full payments to WorldStrides for trip costs. **This is more of a reimbursement program.**

Which Busch's participate?

Any Busch's in the state of Michigan participates in this program. Cards are good at all locations.
